CARE AND MAINTENANCE

All products are made with high quality materials. To keep your furniture in like new conditions, routine cleanings are the key to keeping years of superior beauty and performance.

Resin products are meant for outdoor and indoor use and harsh weather conditions. However, just like any outdoor product, the elements and lack of cleaning could create stains. Resin products have a surface, and inherent properties that don't hold onto much dirt and grime, simply rinsing with water and wiping with a clean cotton cloth will keep products clean, preferably by blotting to avoid scratches. Remember that dust is abrasive.

To minimize any problems with stains including bird droppings, they shall be cleaned as soon as they are notice, making sure the recommended cleaning procedure is followed. Usually a mild soapy solution and water will do the job. Wipe off dust gently. Use clean water.

If furniture is outside, it's suggested to clean furniture 2 or 3 times a year. A mix of three table spoons of mild liquid soap per gallon of clean water shall be applied on the product with a clean rag or sponge, and thoroughly rubbed on it, after which needs to be rinsed clean with a garden hose. For matte finish furniture, you can use pressure washer. For lacquered furniture do not use pressure washer.

Avoid the use of chemicals, solvents, and abrasive cleaners.

Finish by wiping off with a dry clean cloth. If a few stains still remain, more solution should be added and the above process repeated. Never forcefully wipe off dust.

Standard commercial use for seating has a maximum weight limitation of 300 Lbs.

Cushions are for outdoor use. They shall be dry to avoid moisture that can lead to the formation of mold stains inside the cushion.

Never pressure wash or use abrasive solutions on lacquered products.
